COUNCIL OF MINISTERS

RESOLUTION № 126

24 June 1980

REFERENCE: Rendering free aid to the People's Democratic Republic of
Yemen

THE BUREAU OF THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS ORDERS:

1. To deliver to PDR Yemen free of charge armament ammunitions and equipment at the total amount of 190 000 leva, according to the enclosed annex.
2. The Ministry of defense and the Ministry of supplies and state reserves – Main Directorate of the state reserve, shall provide the equipment and deliver it in appropriate packing to the Ministry of foreign trade – “Kintex” for further transportation to PDR Yemen.
3. The Ministry of finance shall provide “Kintex” with funds in leva and foreign currency to cover transportation expenses.

4. The State planning committee and the Ministry of finance shall replenish the stocks of equipment of the Ministry of defense in 1981.
